Subject:- Fulfilment of the conditions mentioned in the Swachh Bharat Mission (Grameen)  
Phase-II operational guidelines in respect of release of funds to the States/UTs- reg.

Madam/Sir,

I am directed to refer to the provisions in Chapter 16 of the SBM-G Phase-II operational guidelines regarding release of funds to the States/UTs on the basis of their performance and ability to achieve the programme results. As per the guidelines, there are various mandatory conditions which are required to be fulfilled by the States/UTs in order to become eligible for release of funds under Swachh Bharat Mission (Grameen) Phase II.

2. Accordingly, all the States/UTs are requested to ensure that following conditions, as mentioned in the guidelines, are compulsorily fulfilled and compliance is intimated to this Department:


- i. Passing a resolution by the State Cabinet to implement the SBM(G) Phase II and commitment of timely release of State share for the programme.
- ii. Setting up of suggested institutional arrangement for implementation and management of SBM(G) Phase II components by the State.
- iii. Agrees to devolve funds to Gram Panchayats for co-financing of SBM(G) components. In this regard, the State Government will provide an undertaking that funds earmarked under 15<sup>th</sup> Finance Commission grants for sanitation activities have been/are being devolved to rural local bodies.

3. Apart from above, the State/UTs are also requested to follow and comply with the other provisions as well regarding release of funds from Centre to State level implementing body as provided in Chapter 16 of the Guidelines.

4. It is also to inform that under SBM(G) Phase II the funds will be released on 'Just-in-time' basis as per absorbing capacity of the States/UTs and on fulfilment of the above-mentioned conditions as per SBM(G) Phase-II guidelines. Non-compliance of the same will affect the future release of GoI share under the programme.

5. It is, therefore, requested to ensure that conditions mentioned in the guidelines for release of funds may be fulfilled and compliance/relevant documents in this regard may be furnished to this Department at the earliest.
